DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in any manner inconsistent with its label. Each TRI-CHLOR 3" tablet (6.0 oz) provides approximately 2.0 ppm of available chlorine in 10,000 gallons of water. This product will correct pH or alkalinity of water and remove debris from the pool skimmer or any appropriate filter.

REGULAR USE

Add 1 to 2 tablets for each 10,000 gallons of water every day or as needed to maintain a residual from 1.0 to 3.0 ppm. Frequency of application will depend upon bather load, weather, dirt and debris. Test for chlorine and pH. Maintain total alkalinity in the range of 100 to 150 ppm at all times. Check and adjust at least once a week.

**ADDITIONAL POOL CARE
RECOMMENDATIONS**

pH - Maintaining pH in the ideal range is extremely important for full benefit of chlorine and swimming comfort. Test at least once a day with a suitable test kit as necessary using liquid or dry test kits. Follow instructions.

SHOCKING OR SUPERCHLORINATING

Shock your water sparkling clear by adding 10,000 gallons of Shocktrine™ or 10,000 gallons of DICHLOR per 10,000 gallons of water once a week, especially during periods when bather loads are high, when the water comes dull looking or hazy, when there is a chlorine like smell, or excessive eye irritation after rains.

Before swimming, allow the pool to maintain a chlorine residual drops to 3.0 ppm.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed container not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or flame. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container with water to dissolve all material before disposal. Place in a trash collection or disposal site, landfill area, or bury in a safe place. CONTAMINATION OR DECOMPOSITION OF THIS PRODUCT IN AN OPEN OR RESEAL CONTAINER. If possible, isolate from open air or well ventilated area. For large volume of water, avoid breathing fumes from contaminated material in an appropriate place.
