LAUNDRY/HOUSEHOLD USAGE

CAUTION:

Concentrated and must be diluted before using

LAUNDRY:

Add 1/2 cup So-White Bleach to each 2 gallons of water in washing machine. Top load machines add 1/2 cup per load. For use only on white or color-fast fabrics. Do not use on silk, rayon. Always put the bleach into the washer first. Adding bleach after the clothes are in may run clothes.

STAINING:

Use on white or color-fast materials (be sure to test material in an inconspicuous place prior to bleaching) in cold water for 10 minutes. Cleanse any starch out with a good detergent and rinse garment. Add 1/2 cup So-White Bleach to each quart of cold fresh water. Mix well and immerse garment. Rinse well in clear water.

TOILET:

First flush out substantial matter. Use 1 oz. of So-White Bleach per 2 gallons of water. Allow to soak for 1 hour before washing.

BOWLS:

Add 1/2 cup So-White Bleach and lightly swab with a toilet brush. Allow to stand for 10 minutes, then flush. Do not use with toilet bowl cleaners or other household chemicals.

INSURANCE INFORMATION
To disinfect sanitary ware (metal, ceramic, plastic, wood, etc.) use 1/2 cup So-White Bleach per 2 gallons of water. Floors, unpainted wood and sisal, brown, blue, green, red, etc. dyes, may be damaged by bleaching.
1. Scrape and prewash utensils and glasses when possible.
2. Wash with a good detergent or compatible cleaner.
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 1 ounce So-White Bleach to 2 gallons of water (200 PPM). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing sanitary Code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.
6. Do not rinse.

DANGER
