## USE DIRECTIONS

For light duty cleaning, sanitizing, and deodorizing, use 2 ounces per gallon.

For heavy duty cleaning and disinfecting and fungicidal activity against pathogenic fungi, use 4.5 ounces per gallon.

For best results, use ENER-JET CD 16 with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces. If used for sanitization of food contact items, limit the level to 200 ppm of quaternary (8 ounces per 5 gallons). **NO RINSE REQUIRED** at this level.

For extra heavy industrial cleaning and sanitizing, use a second application.

DO NOT mix with soap or anionic solutions.

ENER-JET CD 16 is non-corrosive in use dilutions on inanimate hard surfaces.

ENER-JET CD 16 is a heavy duty cleaner and disinfectant designed for general purpose use where heavy duty cleaning and sanitizing is of prime importance. When used as directed, ENER-JET CD 16 will remove most household dirt and grime in a single, simple application. When used for industrial cleaning, follow the use directions shown above.

Not recommended for Pseudomonas.

For sanitization of food processing equipment or food contact items, limit the active quaternary to 200 ppm. At this level No Potable Water Rinse is required.

**DANGER:** Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**FIRST AID:** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.
