**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**TABEX** Slow Dissolving Chlorination Tablets are an extremely convenient form of swimming pool sanitizing agent. **TABEX** Chlorination Tablets are designed to dissolve slowly and at a uniform rate the day following the installation of frequent hand feeding of granular or liquid chlorination.

**FOR CONTINUOUS DAILY CHLORINATION**

Before the first use of **TABEX** Chlorination Tablets, check the NATIONAL TAPES to be sure to take the following steps:

A. Adjust the pool water level to between 7 1/2 and 7 3/4 feet from the **TABEX** Chlorination Tablets. If the pool is not at this level, adjust the water level to 7 1/2 feet from the top of the pool.

B. Stop the pool water circulation system with the chlorinator and closed or containerize.

C. Open the pool water circulation system with the chlorinator and force level up to **TABEX** Chlorination Tablets. Turn the chlorinator on.

**DANGER**

Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may cause a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of toxic fumes, gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of fire, all materials in decomposition do not reseat container. If possible, isolate container in a well-ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water if the container is broken.

**PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

If swallowed, feed bread soaked in milk followed by olive oil or mineral oil. Call a physician IMMEDIATELY. If on skin, brush off excess chemical and flush skin with cool water for at least 15 minutes. If inhaled, get medical attention. If in eyes, flush with cool water for at least 15 minutes. GET MEDICAL ATTENTION.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Keep product dry in tightly closed container. When not in use, store in a well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of damage, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amount of water. Remove all materials before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose of in approved landfill area or bury in a safe place.
