Tabex Liquid Algaecide 1200 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming po exterior spas, whirlopols, and hot tubs. For maximum effectiveness pools, si whirlpools, and hot tube containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to us Tabex Liquid Algaecide 1200.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 71 to 109 fluid ounce Tabex Liquid Algaecide 1200 per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae de by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 39 to 71 to ounces of Tabex Liquid Algaecide 1200 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additi of 13 to 26 fluid ounces of Tabex Liquid Algaecide 1200 per 10,000 gallons of water sho be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose to 11 fluid ounces of Tabex Liquid Algaecide 1200 per 1000 gallons of water. For treatm of a freshly cleaned and filled spa, whirtpool, or hot tub, add initially 4 to 7 fluid ounce Tabex Liquid Algaecide 1200 per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 is fluid ounces of Tabex Liquid Algaecide 1200 should be made every 5 to 7 days after in

creatment for maintenance. Tabex Liquid Algaecide 1200 is compatible with those chemicals normally used to t pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Tabex Liquid Algeocide 1 can be used in pools and spes treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amo of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Tabex Liquid Algeecide 1 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
