This product is specially packaged for use with the efficient 3-sink procedure.

- 1) Thoroughly flush or scrape gross soil and residues from the items to be washed in the hot detergent solution in sink #1. After washing....
- 2) Rinse the items in the solution in sink #2.
- 3) To sanitize items, prepare the solution as follows: add the contents of one 3 oz. package of HY-Q-75 to 12 gallons of hot water in sink #3. Mix thoroughly. (This mix will produce a solution of 150 PPM active ingredient strength when tested with QT-30 test paper.) Each item should be immersed in this solution for at least 60 seconds. Remove, and let each item air-dry on rack or drainboard.

Fresh solution should be prepared daily, when the solution becomes visibly dirty or when it tests below 150 PPM with the test paper...whichever occurs first.
