

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For sanitizing food processing equipment, sink tops, countertops, refrigerated storage and display equipment, and other non-porous surfaces too large to immerse. No potable water rinse is required.

Remove gross food particles from surface by preflushing or prescraping equipment. Clean thoroughly with a hot detergent solution. Rinse thoroughly with clean water. Spray HY-Q-75-SP directly onto the clean surface until thoroughly wetted. Surfaces should remain wet for at least one minute. Allow to drain and air dry. Do not rinse. Should the solution of HY-Q-75-SP become diluted or soiled, dispose. Do not use soiled solution to sanitize.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Keep containers of HY-Q-75-SP tightly sealed. Avoid excessive exposure of the solution to air.

Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
