WAYS IN WHICH INSECTS MAY BE ATTRACTED

Insects have light, heat, and odor sensors on their bodies. These sensors act as a radar guide to food, heat, and shelter.

SANITATION

This is the most important step for insect control. Clean all surfaces. All spilled foods, and garbage, etc. should be cleaned up and removed. All garbage cans should be washed out so the odors will not attract insects.

DIRECTIONS:

FLIES, MOSQUITOS, GNATS, FLYING ADULT MOTHS: First, determine the amount of cubic feet to be sprayed. For example: 10' high x 10' long x 10' wide = 1000 cubic feet. Spray from 2 to 5 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Spray insecticide in every direction. Thoroughly mist the room so that a visible fog is present. Fans operating in the room will speed up circulation of the fog. Allow area to remain closed for 15 minutes. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

RICE WEEVILS, CHOCOLATE MOTHS, DRUG STORE BEETLES, GRANARY WEEVILS, CIGARETTE BEETLES, CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, RUSTY GRAIN BEETLES, RED FLOUR BEETLES, CADELLE, SAWTOOTH GRAIN BEETLES, AND SPIDER BEETLES in exposed adult and larvae stages:

Spray as many insects as possible when treating crack, corners, machinery, crevices, dark secluded areas, or other areas where infestation may occur. Treatment should be repeated weekly or when insects appear.
