

This product is designed for use in homes, hotels, motels, schools, offices, factories and similar environments. It can be used to clean as well as disinfect and deodorize. It is effective on environmental surfaces such as floors, walls, woodwork, bathroom fixtures, shower stalls, animal quarters, air conditioner filters, evaporative cooler pads, and public conveyances. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse small containers well and discard. Return large containers such as drums to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and bury in a safe place.

WARNING:

FIRST AID:

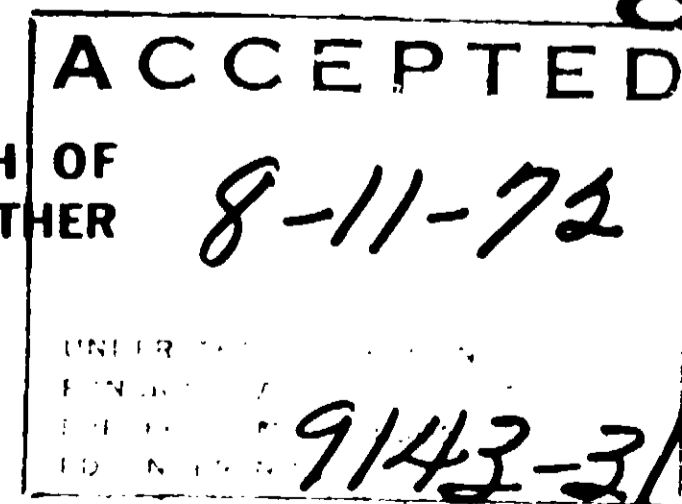

DIRECTIONS

Do not mix this product with other cleaners or disinfectants as the resulting mixture may not have germicidal qualities. Apply disinfectant solution to surfaces liberally with a mop or brush while agitating and allow to stand for a minimum of 10 minutes. For very dirty surfaces, clean surface with disinfectant solution, rinse clean and re-apply, allowing to stand for 10 minutes. Rinse thoroughly with clean water. For disinfecting walls, floors, animal quarters, air conditioner filters, evaporative cooler pads and public conveyances, use a solution strength of two ounces per gallon of water. For disinfecting restroom floors and fixtures, shower stalls, garbage cans, toilets and diaper pails, use a solution strength of three ounces per gallon of water. Before disinfecting inside toilets, expel residual water past trap or pour three ounces of undiluted disinfectant into the toilet bowl.
