## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

GENERAL: HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. SHAKE OCCASIONALLY DURING USE.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATING AGAINST HIV-1 (AIDS VIRUS) ON SURFACES/OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS: WEAR DISPOSABLE GLOVES, GOWNS, MASKS, OR EYE COVERINGS WHEN HANDLING ITEMS SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS. BLOOD AND OTHER BODY FLUIDS MUST BE THOROUGHLY CLEANED FROM SURFACES AND OBJECTS BEFORE APPLICATION OF THIS DISINFECTANT. FOR DEODORIZING THE AIR:
