Submission dated March 21, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. For product 9143-65, revise the total inert ingredient percentage declaration on the label to include the "Related Compounds" percentage. Do not list the "Related Compounds" separately as an active ingredient.
2. For product 9143-65, ensure that the signal word "CAUTION" and the statement "Keep out of reach of children" are prominently displayed on the front panel and not obscured with other text.
3. For product 9143-60, the statement "CONTAINS PETROLEUM DISTILLATES" must appear on the label directly below the ingredients statement.
3. For product 9143-68, revise the "INERT INGREDIENTS" total percentage to include the "Related compounds" from d-trans allethrin. Do not combine the "Related compounds" percentage with the "d-trans ALLETHRIN" percentage as an active ingredient.

4. For product 9143-60, reinstate the isomer ratio substatement for d-cis/trans phenothrin.



**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS  
CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product  
in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.**

**TO KILL FLIES, GNATS, MOSQUITOES AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS:** Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.

**TO KILL ANTS, CENTIPEDES, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, FIREBRATS, SOWBUGS AND SPIDERS:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

**TO KILL CARPET BEETLES:** Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

**TO KILL EXPOSED FORMS OF CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, RICE WEEVILS, AND SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES:** Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

**TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS IN PET BEDDING AND PET AREAS:** Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. To reduce infestation, thoroughly spray the animal's bedding, sleeping quarters, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, local areas of floors, and other resting places until the surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray the entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. **DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS.** Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to reenter treated area.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not
