c. Under the Directions for Use add:

Use only in well-ventilated areas. If clothing is sprayed during application, remove clothing immediately after spraying and launder before wearing again.

All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until sprays have dried.

d. Add the following under the Precautionary Statements:

Do not apply this pesticide in the immediate area when occupants are present. Use only in a well ventilated area. Do not apply this pesticide when classrooms are in use.

## PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Remove cap, hold upright, point valve opening away from person. Hold can about 12 inches from surface being sprayed. Use as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet.

**TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS:** Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do not spray animals.

**TO KILL ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, WATER BUGS, SPIDERS, CRICKETS:** Direct spray into cracks, on baseboards, window and door trim, under cabinets, stoves, sinks, and around pipes. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as necessary.

**TO KILL CARPET BEETLES:** Make localized application to areas of floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpet and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary.

**FOR CONTROL OF FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS** in kennels or outdoor dog houses, spray all floor surfaces, cracks, and crevices higher than twelve inches.

**TO KILL MOSQUITOES, FLIES, WASPS AND CERTAIN OTHER FLYING INSECTS:** Spray on surfaces of screens, doors and window frames, porches, light fixtures, garages and other places where the insects alight, congregate, or wherever insects may enter room.

**RESIDUAL TYPE — DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY FOR EFFECTIVE CONTROL REPEAT AS NECESSARY**

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
