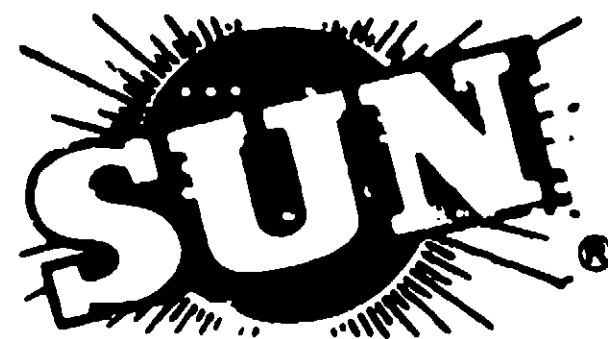

Active Ingredient:  
\*Dodecylbenzyl Trimethyl Ammonium Chloride 50%  
Inert Ingredient: Water ..... 50%  
\*C12 - 95% CB - C-18 - 5%  
Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

**DANGER:**

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Do not use with soap or anionic detergents.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**Initial Application**

2 ounces per 3910 gals. water or ratio thereof.

**Continuing Application**

1 ounce in 7820 gallons of water every 3-5 days when the weather is warm-humid. In cool or cloudy weather, the above dose every week.

**Booster Application**

1 ounce per 7820 of water after a heavy or prolonged rainfall, or when there is a heavy bathing load.

The Above directions should be followed even when the pool is not in use.
