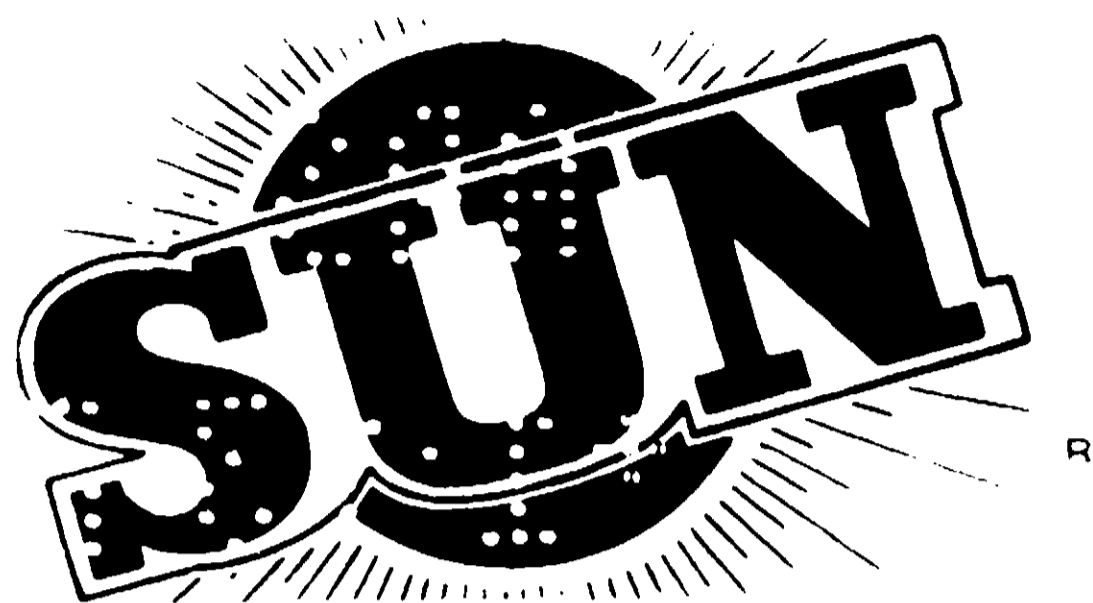

Active Ingredients: Trichloro-s-triazinetriene 99.5%
Inert Ingredients5%
90% Available chlorine by weight

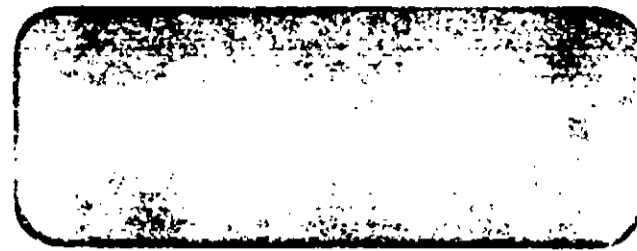

CONDITIONING AND PREPARING YOUR POOL

- A Add Sun Conditioner (Cyanuric Acid) slowly through the skimmer, 1 lb. per 3,000 gallons pool water. This is done only once at the beginning of the pool season. Conditioning is not necessary BUT by doing so it reduces the effect of sunlight on the chlorine concentrate and enables you to maintain a chlorine residual longer.
- B To prevent the growth of algae, chlorinate at the start of the season with 8 oz. of SUN Chlorine Concentrate Tablets, per 20,000 gallons of pool water. Add the slowly dissolving SUN Concentrated Tablets to the skimmer. Chlorinate when there are no swimmers in the pool. Resume swimming when the Chlorine residual has dropped to 1.0 PPM.
- C Adjust the pH to 7.4 to 7.6. If it is above 7.6, add SUN Dry Acid. If it is below 7.4, add SUN Dry Soda. A pH Test Kit should be used for proper pH adjustment.

DIRECTIONS

Sun Chlorine Concentrate Tablets are formulated to release chlorine throughout the day. It is recommended that they be placed in the skimmer. Recommended dosage: 2 oz. (or 12 tablets) per 10,000 gallons of Pool Water **every day** or as needed to maintain a chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 PPM as determined by a test kit. 6 SUN Chlorine Concentrate tablets weigh 1 ounce.



WARNING

Do not mix with other chemicals. Strong oxidizing agent. Contact with organic material may cause fire. Dust may be harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Keep away from open flames, heaters, or other heat sources. Protect from moisture contamination.


In case of contact with skin or eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes. For eyes, get medical attention. Clean contaminated clothing before reuse.

ANTIDOTE

Externally or in eyes - immediately flush with cold water. Internally - Drink milk or mucilage, followed by cooking oil. Call a physician.

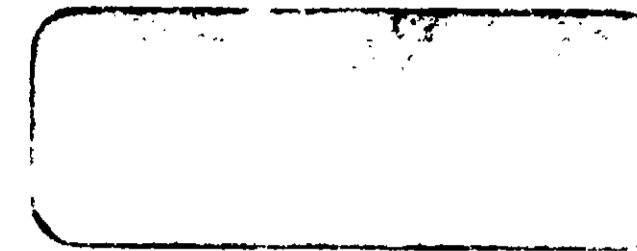

DIRECTIONS

Shut off filter pump and allow pool water to become stationary. Sprinkle SPOT-OUT where algae growth appears, both along pool walls and over surface of water. For heavy algae growth, use 2 pounds per 10,000 gallons of water. For light algae growth use 1 pound per 10,000 gallons of water. Turn on pump after three hours. Do not use until chlorine residual falls below 1 ppm.

SPOT-OUT IS NOT RECOMMENDED FOR USE IN VINYL LINER OR PAINTED POOLS.
