

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Keep out of reach of children.
Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes or on skin. If on clothing, remove clothes or take shirt and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

Container disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent), and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place. Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited burning.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID

Skin and eyes: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with water for 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician.
Ingestion: If swallowed drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if not available large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Initial Application: Ensure that the pool filter and circulating system are functioning properly. To prevent algae growth add 5 fl. oz. Sun Concentrate Algacide per 10,000 gallons of water. If algae are already present, super chlorinate with Sun Granular Stabilized Chlorinating Concentrate following the label directions. Then add Sun Concentrate Algacide at the rate of 5 fl. oz. per 10,000 gallons. Apply to water along pool edges. The effectiveness of these chemical treatments may be enhanced by vigorous brushing of the affected pool surfaces, vacuuming of debris to waste and frequent filter backwashing to ensure complete removal of all algae from the pool.

Maintenance Dose: Use 1 1/2 fl. oz. per 10,000 gallons every week. For very hot weather or heavy bathing load, use this dosage every 5 days. Apply to water along edges.

Booster Dose: After heavy rains or severe storms add 1 1/2 fl. oz. per 10,000 gallons of water. Apply to water along edges.

Pool-Side Surfaces: These surfaces should first be cleaned with a product like Sun Tile and liner Cleaner. Then, use 1/2 fl. oz. of Sun Algacide Concentrate to 5 gallons of water to wash down and disinfect the area.

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
