DANGER

PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Initial Application: For a pool without visible algae present add 5 fl oz per 10,000 gallons. If algae is already present, super-chlorinate with Sun Granular Chlorinating Concentrate following the label directions. Then add Sun Algaecide Concentrate at the rate given above.

Maintenance Dose: Use 1 1/2 fl oz per 10,000 gallons every week. For very hot weather or heavy bathing load use this dosage every 5 days.

Boost Dose: After heavy rains or severe storms add 1/2 fl oz per 10,000 gallons of water.

Pool-Side Surfaces: Pool-side surfaces should first be cleaned with a product like Sun Tile and Liner Cleaner. Then, use 1/2 fl oz of Sun Algaecide Concentrate to 5 gallons of water to wash down and disinfect the area.

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
