DIRECTIONS

Initial Application: To a cleaned pool add ½ gallon to 40,000 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

Maintenance Dose: Use one pint per 40,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

Booster Dose: Immediately after every rain add one pint per 40,000 gallons of water as above.

Important: Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.

Pool-side surfaces: After cleaning surfaces, use one oz. to six gallons of water for sanitizing or one oz. to 3 gallons of water for disinfecting.

FIRST AID

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, etc., if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge pool water into lakes, streams, or ponds.
