FIRST AID

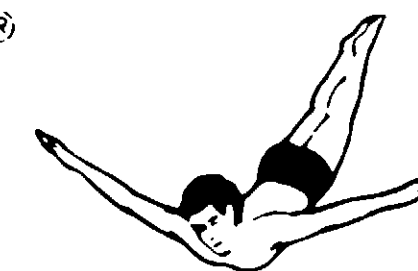
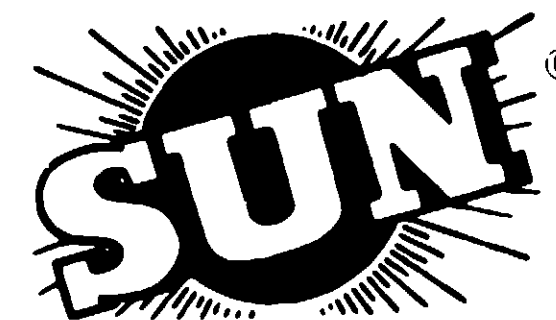

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Initial Application: To a cleaned or when filling pool at beginning of swimming season add one gallon to 50,000 gallons of water, or ratio thereof.

If pool has visible algae growth, treat with initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or reappear repeat this treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae use the recommended maintenance dose.

Maintenance Dose: Use one quart per 50,000 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. When weather is hot or bathing load is heavy, use this dosage every 5 days or as necessary.

Booster Dose: Immediately after every rain add one quart per 50,000 gallons of water as above.

Important: Follow above directions without fail, even when pool is not used. Algae growth must be fought at all times.

Pool-side Surfaces: After cleaning surfaces, use one oz. to four gallons of water for sanitizing or one oz. to two gallons for disinfecting. Apply by wiping, mopping or scrubbing so as to wet surfaces thoroughly with the recommended solutions.

DANGER

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
