**Precautions:** KWELL Cream is indicated for the treatment of scabies (Scabies caused by mites) and pediculosis with head lice (Pediculosis capitis) and crab lice (Phthirus pubis) on the head and neck.

**Contraindications:** KWELL Cream is contraindicated in individuals who are hypersensitive to any of its components. Prompt institution of medical therapy is indicated if allergic reaction occurs, prompt institution of gastric lavage will rid the body of large amounts of the toxicant. However, since oil is not absorbed, saline cathartics for intestinal evacuation should be given rather than oil laxatives. If accidental contact with eyes occurs, flush with water. If irritation or sensitization occurs, discontinue the product and consult physician.

If necessary, a second or a third application may be made at weekly intervals. For Pediculosis: Apply to hairy infested areas and adjacent areas. Apply a thin layer and leave on for 12 to 24 hours. Wash thoroughly. Repeat in four days if necessary.
