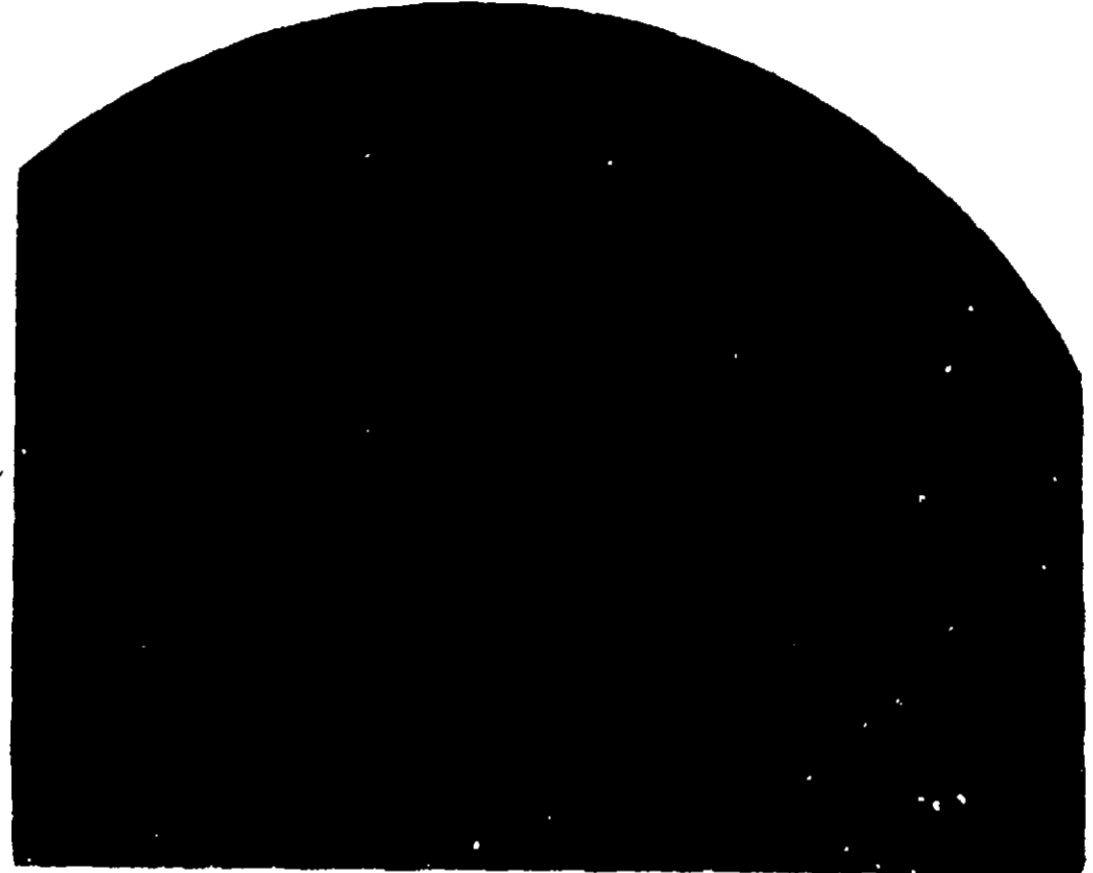

DYNAPHENE disinfectant detergent should be used wherever the properties of a Cleaner combined with Germicidal action are needed. Cleans floors without removing wax or finish while it disinfects, deodorizes and sanitizes. It is safe to use on asphalt, rubber, vinyl, vinyl asbestos, marble, terrazzo, ceramic, and all other types of floors. For stripping and wax removal use one quart Dynaphene to each gallon of water.

The recommended areas for use of Dynaphene are HOMES, OFFICES, HOTELS, MOTELS, SCHOOLS, INDUSTRIAL ESTABLISHMENTS, BATHROOMS, KITCHENS, URINALS, RESTAURANTS, LOCKER ROOMS, GYMNASIUMS, GARBAGE RECEPTACLES. See "Use Dilution" for type of cleaning to be done.

USE DILUTION

1. Daily routine cleaning: Dilute 1 1/4 ounces to 1 gallon of water.
 2. Heavy cleaning and disinfecting: Dilute 2 to 4 ounces to 1 gallon of water.
- For best results use Dynaphene with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors, and other hard surfaces. If used on food contact items, rinse with potable water is required. Rinse empty containers thoroughly with water and discard.
