This is in regard to your label, and Confidential Statement of Formula dated December 7, 1992, re-submitted in response to the Agency letter dated September 28, 1992. The original submission was in response to the Agency letter Dated May 5, 1992 concerning ingredients determined to be pesticidally inert.

The revised labeling and Confidential Statement of Formula referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

1. Before the label statement, "Corrosive: Causes severe eye and skin damage," replace the word CAUTION with DANGER (to match the signal word DANGER on the front panel).

2. Submit five copies of the finished labeling before the product is released for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

For disinfecting, mix 2 ounces of Dynapine No. 5 with one gallon of water. Remove all dirt prior to application of the disinfectant. This dilution is suitable for disinfecting, floors, walls, urinals, toilets, garbage pails, and kennels.

For general cleaning and deodorizing use 3/4 ounce of Dynapine No. 5 with one gallon of water.

Dynapine No. 5 Cleaner is not suitable for use on humans for antiseptic or germicidal properties. If the disinfectant contacts skin or eyes, wash with large quantities of water. Do not take internally. Do not contaminate food products. Harmful if swallowed. If ingested contact physician at once.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
