FOR USE AS A MOUND TREATMENT TO CONTROL FIRE ANTS: Dilute by adding 6 ounces of MR. SCOTT'S FIRE ANT KILLER to one gallon of water. MIX THOROUGHLY. (ALWAYS PREPARE THE RECOMMENDED DILUTION, SINCE A STRONGER SOLUTION MAY CAUSE FIRE ANTS TO ABANDON THE MOUND AND START NEW COLONIES ELSEWHERE.)

Apply one gallon of diluted solution to each fire ant mound. Using a sprinkler container, gently and thoroughly drench the entire mound and surrounding area to a four (4) foot diameter. Do not disturb ants. FOR BEST RESULTS: Apply in cool weather (65-80 degrees F.) or in early morning or late evening hours.

If possible, treat all mounds in the vicinity at the same time. Treat new mounds as they appear.

Larger quantities of diluted solution may be prepared at one time for treating more than one mound, however you must be sure to use one full gallon of diluted solution to each mound and the solution must be applied gently and thoroughly. Diluted solution should be used promptly.

STORAGE OF CONCENTRATED MR. SCOTT'S FIRE ANT KILLER: Should be stored at temperatures above 32 degrees F.

DISPOSAL: DO NOT REUSE EMPTY CONTAINER. RINSE THOROUGHLY BEFORE DISCARDING IN TRASH.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING OR GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated. IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. IF IN EYES: Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. If irritation persists get medical attention.
