DIRECTIONS

AS A DEODORANT

To deodorize vitrified and enameled sanitary ware, enameled refrigerators and other surfaces, oil cloth and linoleum, tile, wooden ware, garbage cans, sick room utensils, wash thoroughly with a good detergent and water and rinse thoroughly. Then apply a solution of three tablespoonfuls of Tappan's Bleach to each quart of cold water to the entire surface to be deodorized, making sure that the deodorizing solution covers the entire surface to be disinfected for five minutes, then rinse in clear water and dry. Repeat if necessary.

AS A DISINFECTANT

To disinfect sanitary ware, metal, enameled metal and vitrified cooking utensils, crockery, dishes and glassware, woodenware, thermos bottles, fruit jars, shower floors and linoleum, wash thoroughly the entire surface to be disinfected with Tappan's detergent and water and when clean, rinse thoroughly with clear water. Then apply a solution of three tablespoonfuls of bleach to each quart of cold water, making sure that the disinfecting solution covers the entire surface to be disinfected for five minutes, then rinse in clear water and dry.
