

**TABLE OF PROPORTIONS  
AVAILABLE CHLORINE**

500 ppm—Use 2 oz. in 3 gallons of water  
 200 ppm—Use 1 oz. in 4 gallons of water  
 100 ppm—Use 1/2 oz. in 8 gallons of water  
 50 ppm—Use 1/4 oz. in 16 gallons of water

D-KLOR is recommended especially for all food processing plants.

Dilution should be made according to recommendations for each specific job. Consult health authorities for local requirements.

Use clean, cool water for rinse solutions.

Solution should be used reasonably soon after mixing to get full strength of contents.

DO NOT SOAK OVERNIGHT. Keep in cool, dark place as light and heat will reduce strength.

**NON-POROUS SURFACES . . .**

On non-porous surfaces after cleaning, use 100 ppm solution where facilities for maintaining 50 ppm concentration are available, or 200 ppm where such facilities are not available.

**POROUS SURFACES . . .**

On porous surfaces use solution providing 500 ppm or more.
