

**DILUTE ACCORDING TO  
REQUIREMENTS FOR  
AVAILABLE CHLORINE  
FOR SPECIFIC USE**

For general sanitizing solution  
1/2 oz. to 100 gallons water equals  
100 ppm.

For daily washing solution 1/4 oz.  
to 100 gallons water equals  
200 ppm.

For contaminated inanimate  
surfaces, 6 oz. to 1000 gallons of  
water gives 6 ppm available  
chlorine.

**SWIMMING POOL TREATMENT**

Use 1 oz. per 1000 gallons of water  
to yield 1 ppm available chlorine.  
Apply as needed to maintain a  
free chlorine residual of 0.6 to  
1.0 ppm as determined by fre-  
quent testing with test kit. Keep  
the pool pH between 7.2 to 7.6  
range.
