The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provision:

Due to new EPA policy, part of the Environmental Hazards section has been changed. To comply, change the sentence "Do not apply to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes)" to read "Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark."

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Please submit five (5) final printed copies for the referenced label, incorporating the above change, before releasing the product for shipment.

Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid breathing dust. Do not contaminate food and feedstuffs. Do not store near seed, fertilizer or other herbicides.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Collect and incorporate granules spilled on the soil surface. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes). Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is in violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DO NOT APPLY IN SUFFOLK COUNTY, LONG ISLAND, NEW YORK.

Application should be made to a uniform weed-free soil surface within two to three days maximum following cultivation to prevent subsurface germinating weeds from becoming established. Disturbing the soil surface following application will reduce effectiveness.

If there is no rain within three or four days after application, sprinkler irrigation (1/2 to 1 inch of water) should be used for best results.

ANY APPLICATION OF THE ANDERSONS CRABGRASS AND ANNUAL WEED PREVENTER SHOULD BE MADE PRIOR TO WEED SEED GERMINATION.

Apply uniformly to established turfgrass at the rate of 8 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. in the early spring before crabgrass and other annual grasses and broadleaved weed seeds germinate. Crabgrass seed germination usually coincides with the time Forsythia blossoms start to fall. One application applied before weed seed germination in early spring usually provides season-long control. Where spring seeding is necessary, there should be a delay of approximately 60 days after the application.

Do not use on putting greens or on bentgrasses when mowed to putting green heights. DO NOT apply to Dichondra.

Use only when wearing a long-sleeved shirt and long-legged pants and chemical resistant gloves.

IMPORTANT! If pesticide comes in contact with skin, wash off with soap and water. Always wash hands, face and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating, drinking, or toileting.

AFTER WORK: Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Take off all work clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not reuse contaminated clothing. Clothing worn during work must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing that becomes heavily contaminated or drenched must be destroyed according to State and local regulations. **HEAVILY CONTAMINATED OR DRENCHED CLOTHING CANNOT BE ADEQUATELY DECONTAMINATED.**

Do not enter treated areas for 24 hours after application unless wearing long-sleeved shirt and long pants.

GROUNDWATER ADVISORY: Tetrachloroterephthalic acid, a breakdown product of Dacthal, is known to leach through soil as a result of agricultural and turf uses and has been found in groundwater which may be used for drinking water. Users are advised not to apply Dacthal to sand and loamy sand soils where the water table (groundwater) is close to the surface and where these soils are very permeable, i.e. well drained. Your local agricultural agencies can provide further information on the type of soil in your area and the location of groundwater used for drinking water.

APPROXIMATE SPREADER SETTINGS

(available at final label printing)

The rates of application are given for 1,000 square feet (for example, an area 20 ft. x 50 ft. = 1,000 sq. ft.). To determine the correct amount for a specific area, measure the area and proportion the rate. As an example, if an area is 10 ft. x 25 ft. = 250 sq. ft. a rate of 1/4 the amount recommended for 1,000 sq. ft. is appropriate.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Keep container closed and away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Carefully wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse bag. Discard bag in trash.
