At this rate, the product will control chinch bugs, sod webworms (fawn moths), ants. <u>billbugs</u>, brown dog ticks, crickets, culworms, earwigs, grasshoppers, armyworms, centipedes, clover mites, fiery skipper, fleas, greenbugs, June beetles, leafhoppers, millipedes, mites, mosquitoes, sowbugs and ticks.

Treat when insects first appear, re-treat as necessary. For best results, product should be watered in after application.

## **GRUB CONTROL**

Apply at the rate of 5-10 lbs. per 1000 square feet. At this rate, the product will control certain white grubs (larvae of European chaffer and Japanese beetle).

Treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface. Consult your local agricultural extension service for proper time to treat in your area. For best results, product should be thoroughly watered in to wash the insecticide into the zone of insect infestation.

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To control Hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils, uniformly apply 5 pounds of granules per 1,000 sq. ft. as directed above. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialists for best time to treat in your area.
