Dear Registrant:

The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, successfully REMOVES THE PRODUCT FROM THE SCOPE of PR Notice 93-7 one the comments (if any) on the attached sheet are addressed. Other than the alterations (if any) listed on the attached sheet, no further alterations to the labeling are necessary to reflect the requirements of the Worker Protection Standard.

Since your amendment proposes to delete uses directly and/or to delete uses implicitly through the use of exclusionary statements), the Agency will publish in the Federal Register a notice of receipt of your amendment to delete uses, as required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA. The Agency will defer action for 90 days from the date of the Federal Register notice to give affected minor users an opportunity to try to persuade you to retain the uses(s). When the comment period has expired, the Agency will approve the amendment unless you have withdrawn it, and stamp the amended labeling "accepted." Your stamped-accepted labeling will then be sent to you.

As described in Supplement A of PR Notice 93-11 (self-verification option), you may sell and distribute product bearing the submitted labeling before you receive a copy of your stamped-accepted labeling. Note that your registration is not amended until the comment period required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA has expired and the Agency has approved the amendment. Therefore, you may withdraw your proposed amendment at any time during the comment period and until you receive your stamped-accepted labeling.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on plants are highly susceptible. Do not apply directly to water. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

Tee Time 20-4-10 with Benefin/Dursban(R) Brand Insecticide is a combination of growth promoting fertilizer ingredients, a preemergence herbicide and a turf insecticide. It is designed to control smooth and large (hairy) crabgrass, goosegrass (silver crabgrass or crowsfoot), barnyard grass (watergrass), yellow and green foxtail, annual bluegrass (Poa Annua), as well as ants, armyworms, brown dog ticks, chinch bugs, crickets, cutworms, earwigs, grasshoppers, and sod webworms. When applied as directed, the following established turf grasses are tolerant: perennial bluegrasses, perennial ryegrass, lescue and zoysia grass. This product will not harm nearby established ornamental trees and shrubs.

Apply prior to the germination of weed grasses since it will not control established weeds. Precise time of application for a specific area will vary because of climate and individual cultural practices. Consult Agricultural Experiment Station or extension service turf grass specialists for additional information regarding specific weed germination times in your area.

Because of varying cultural practices, this product should not be used on putting greens, dichondra, bentgrass, turf, bermudagrass, St. Augustine grass, or centipede grass. This product may thin fine-leaved fescues at rates above 215 pounds per acre (2 lbs. active Benefin). In areas where annual bluegrass (Poa Annua) is present as a desirable species, this product should not be applied. In areas that have been overseeded with winter grasses, a spring application may thin the overseeded grasses. To prevent thinning of desirable grasses, it should not be applied in the spring to turf grasses planted the previous fall and reseeding of the new areas should be delayed at least 6 weeks after application.

Because Tee Time 20-4-10 with Benefin/Dursban(R) Brand Insecticide is generally applied very early in the insect cycle, it may be necessary to give a second treatment of insecticide late in the season. Do not apply this combination product twice in the same season.

Any cultural practices that disturb the soil, such as aerification or verticutting, should be done prior to application. This material must be adequately watered into the soil for best results. Check application rate of your spreader before and during application.

How To Apply: Apply at the rate of 5 pounds per 1,000 sq.ft. (50 ft. x 20 ft. - 1,000 sq.ft.). For best control, this product must be applied evenly over the turf without skips or misses. Best results are obtainable by using a two-step procedure, which applies half the required amount on the first trip over the area. Spread the second half of the required amount over the same area by moving at right angles to the first application in a checkerboard fashion. This procedure will minimize the chances of color streaking and erratic insect/crabgrass control. Do not over or under apply. Over application can weaken turf grasses during stress periods allowing fungus or insects to cause damage.

Annual Bluegrass (Poa Annua) Control: For preemergence control, apply 5 pounds per 1,000 sq.ft. in late summer to early fall (mid-July to mid-September) or in early spring prior to seed germination. In areas of heavy infestation, the elimination of Poa Annua will temporarily result in thin turf areas. Proper fertilization with Tee Time and irrigation will encourage existing turf grasses to fill in these thin areas.

Crabgrass, Goosegrass, Watergrass, and Foxtail Control: Apply in the spring 2 to 4 weeks prior to expected annual weed grass seed germination at 5 pounds per 1,000 sq.ft.

Ant, Armyworms, Chinch Bugs, Crickets, Brown Dog Ticks, Cutworm, Earwig. Grasshopper, Sod Webworm Control: Tee Time 20-4-10 with Benefin/Dursban(R) Brand Insecticide will control these insects present at the time of or soon after treatment when applied at the same rate for preemergent control of the listed weed species.
