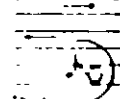
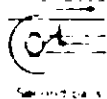
### HOW TO APPLY

For best results, Anderson's Crabgrass Preventer must be applied evenly with broadcast spreaders. First determine the amount of product to use per acre. For established lawns, apply at 4 pounds per 1,000 square feet. For example, a 1/2 acre lawn (50,000 sq. ft.) would require 200 lbs. of product. The best results are obtained by using the recommended rate at the recommended time. Applications should be made in the fall or early spring. Do not apply to vegetable crops. Do not hand spread.

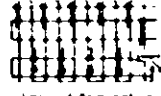
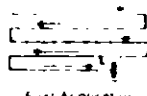
### CYCLONE TYPE SPREADERS

Use the recommended settings for the half rate application. Move at a steady pace in one direction. On the return trip, adjust the spreader so the outer edge of the spread material falls between the wheel tracks of the first pass. The third pass should fall between the wheel tracks of the second and so on.



### DROP TYPE SPREADERS

Use the recommended settings for the half rate application. Cover the lawn in one direction. Turn the spreader off at the corners of when stopping. Spread the other half of the required amount over the same area including at right angles to the first application in a checkerboard pattern. This minimizes skips or overlaps, insuring good coverage.



When the two step procedure is not practical, apply this product in one trip over the lawn using the one step settings listed below. Be careful to cover the lawn completely, since crabgrass can grow in spots missed.

The recommended settings listed herein are calculated for applying Anderson's Crabgrass Preventer at a rate of 4 pounds per 1,000 square feet. One step settings are listed for use when a one trip will be made over the lawn. Check application rate of your spreader before and during application. Settings can vary with type, age and condition of spreader. Fill spreader on driveway or sidewalk to avoid spillage on grass.
