Dear Ms. Walters:


The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments specified in this letter as listed below:

- 1) Add to the Precautionary Statements and begin with "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin". Causes moderate eye irritation". Revise the statements "Wash thoroughly.....Wash... to "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling" " Remove contaminated clothing and wash thoroughly before reuse". Delete remaining statements.
- 2) Remove from the Precautionary Statements "Do not treat vegetable gardens or other plants used for food purposes".
- 3) Add under the Directions for Use "Do not allow the public, especially children, on treated areas during treatment and until the pesticide is washed into the soil and the turf is completely dry".
- 4) The sub-heading for Storage and Disposal is missing.

A stamped copy of the label "accepted with comments" is enclosed for your records.

This pesticide is toxic to birds, fish and aquatic invertebrates. Birds feeding in treated areas may be killed. Clean up spilled product to reduce exposure to wildlife. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Runoff may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

SURFACE INSECT CONTROL

Apply at the rate of 2.6-3.6 lbs. per 1000 square feet, or the equivalent of 0.75-1.0 lbs. actual active ingredient per acre. At this rate, the product will control chinch bugs, sod webworms (lawn moths), ants, billbugs, brown dog ticks, crickets, cutworms, earwigs, grasshoppers, armyworms, centipedes, clover mites, fiery skipper, fleas, greenbugs, June beetles, leafhoppers, millipedes, mites, mosquitoes, sowbugs and ticks.

Treat when insects first appear, re-treat as necessary.

The following advisory statement is optional and may be omitted by some subregistrants:
For best results, product should be watered in after application.

GRUB CONTROL

Apply at the rate of 2.6 – 3.6 lbs. per 1000 square feet, or the equivalent of 0.75 – 1.0 lbs. actual active ingredient per acre. At this rate, the product will control certain white grubs (larvae of European chaffer and Japanese beetle).

Treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface. Consult your local agricultural extension service for proper time to treat in your area. For best results, product should be thoroughly watered in to wash the insecticide into the zone of insect infestation.

To control Hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils, uniformly apply 3.6 pounds of granules per 1,000 sq. ft. as directed above. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialists for best time to treat in your area.

Maximum application rate is 1 lb. ai per acre (3.6 pounds of product per 1,000 square feet).
