The revised labeling reference to above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided you incorporate the changes required by the Agency as listed below.

Direction for use sites	<p>Add the following sentence listing sites where the product may be used as the lead sentence in the second paragraph:</p> <p>"For use on turf on golf courses, road medians, and industrial plant sites only. Not for use on turf being grown for sale"</p>
Directions for use keep off grass limitation	<p>1) Remove sentence "Do not allow children or pets on lawn until 1/2" of water" from the front panel precautionary text. This is not the correct location and the terms "children", "pets", and "lawn" are problematic for this non-residential product.</p> <p>2) Add the following sentence to the Directions for Use as the lead paragraph in the Use Precautions section:</p> <p>"Keep the public off treated turf until 1/2" of water has been applied to the turf and the water has dried (or, if wet conditions persist, until 24 hours have passed)."</p>

Directions for Use spreader settings	Spreader settings must be included on label.

Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling incorporating the above changes prior to releasing your product for shipment. If the above provisions are not complied with the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

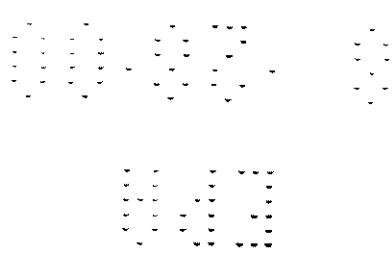

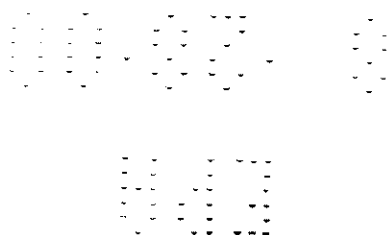

It is in violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Andersons Tee Time 19-5-9 with Team/Dursban is a combination of growth promoting fertilizer ingredients, a preemergent herbicide, and a turf insecticide. It is designed to control smooth and hairy crabgrass, goosegrass (silver crabgrass or crow'sfoot), barnyard grass (watergrass), green and yellow foxtail, and annual bluegrass (*Poa annua*), as well as ants, armyworms, billbugs, brown dog ticks, chinch bugs, crickets, cutworms, earwigs, grasshoppers, and sod webworms.

When applied as directed, the product can be used on the following turfs: Kentucky Bluegrass, perennial ryegrasses, centipede grass, fescue, zoysiagrass, bermudagrass, St. Augustine grass, and bahiagrass. The product will not harm nearby established ornamental trees and shrubs.

Application Directions

Apply at the rate of 4 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. Andersons Tee Time 19-5-9 with Team/Dursban has been specially formulated to be used by itself or it can provide a second weed and insect kill by using it as a follow-up application to The Andersons Tee Time product which delivers two pounds of herbicide and one pound of insecticide.

Maximum application rate is 1 lb. ai per acre (4 pounds of product per 1,000 square feet).

Use Precautions

Apply Andersons Tee Time with Team/Dursban to the turf prior to the germination of weed grasses since Andersons Tee Time with Team/Dursban will not control established weeds. Andersons Tee Time with Team/Dursban should not be applied in the spring to turfgrass planted the previous fall. In bermudagrass areas that have been overseeded with winter grasses, a spring application of Andersons Tee Time with Team/Dursban should not be used on putting greens. Andersons Tee Time with Team/Dursban should not be used on dichondra. Andersons Tee Time with Team/Dursban should not be applied to newly sprigged areas of bermudagrass, St. Augustine grass or Centipede grass until these turfs are well established.

Reseeding

Chemicals that effectively control annual weed seeds may also affect new desirable turfgrass seedlings. Reseeding should be delayed for at least 6 weeks after applying Andersons Tee Time with Team/Dursban. When reseeding, it is essential that proper cultural practices such as soil cultivation, irrigation and fertilization be followed. For satisfactory reseeding results after using Andersons Tee Time with Team/Dursban the amount of seed used should be increased and equipment designed to place seed in contact with the soil (such as Roger Aze Seder) should be employed. When using Andersons Tee Time with Team/Dursban at the highest recommended rate, reseeding should be delayed 12 to 16 weeks after application.

Application Equipment

Apply Andersons Tee Time with Team/Dursban evenly over the turfgrass area without skips or misses. A more uniform application can be made with broadcast (rotary) type spreaders by spreading half the required amount over the area and then applying the remaining half at the right angles. Both drop type and rotary type spreaders may be used. Avoid the use of spreaders which would apply the material in narrow, concentrated bands. Calibrate applicators prior to use according to the manufacturer's directions. Check frequently to be sure equipment is working properly and distributing uniformly.

Storage: Store in original container only. In cases of spill, contain material and dispose as waste.
