

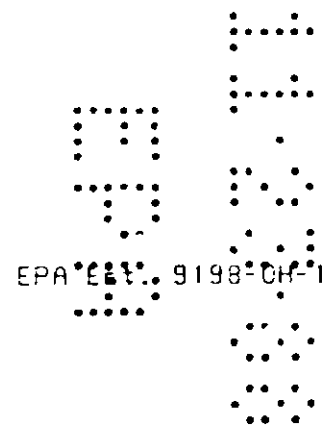

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

CAUTION

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.

Material is available inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes or skin. Do not breathe dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, vomiting should be induced. Administer water orally and induce vomiting by giving one dose of 10 cc or 15 ml. of syrup or liquid. If vomiting does not occur within 10 to 20 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup or liquid is not available, induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Place patient in a prone and keep quiet. Professional medical assistance should be secured immediately. If on skin, remove clothing and wash with immediately with soap and warm water. If in eyes, flush with flowing water for at least 15 minutes.

Do not contaminate feed or food. Wash out thoroughly. If poisoning occurs, obtain prompt medical aid. Prolonged exposure will result in indigestion and depression.

To Physician: Atropine sulfate is antidote. D-PEM is also antidote and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

PROTECT WILDLIFE

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife and is extremely toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Apply in strict accordance with label directions. Do not use on crops used for food or storage. Use only according to label directions.

RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS ON LAWNS

WHITE GRUBS: Apply Tee Time Insecticide with Cylox uniformly at the rate of 3-4 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. with an accurately calibrated lawn spreader. For best results, mow lawn and rake dead grass from damaged spots before applying. After applying, uniformly, water lawn using 15-30 gallons per 1000 sq. ft. Do not water again for at least three days. Reapply as necessary at one to three week intervals. In most areas, the first application should be May or June. Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station or State Extension Service specialists for more specific information regarding timing of applications.

SOD WEBWORMS (LAWN MOTHS): Apply Tee Time Insecticide with Cylox at the rate of 2-4 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. using the above application techniques and recommendations.
