



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

CAUTION

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.

If swallowed and dissolved undiluted, can penetrate through skin. Avoid contact with eyes or mucous membranes. Do not breathe dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reusing.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, vomiting should be induced. Instructed victim to vomit and induce vomiting by giving one dose of 1/2 oz. of syrup of ipecac. If vomit is not vomited within 10 to 30 minutes, administer second dose. If syrup of ipecac is not available, induce vomiting by touching tongue to back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Have patient lie down and keep quiet. Professional medical assistance should be secured immediately. If on skin, remove clothes and wash skin immediately with soap and warm water. If in eyes, flush with flowing water for at least 15 minutes.

If not contaminated feed on bread. Keep out of reach of children. In case of swallowing accident, obtain prompt medical aid. Challenge the patient with bright orange juice or depression.

To Physician: Atropine sulfate is antidote. Dose: 1/4 gm. to adult anticholinesterase may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

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ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

PROTECT WILDLIFE

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife and is extremely toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Apply in strict accordance with label instructions. Do not apply when weather conditions favor runoff from areas treated. Do not apply to water or wetlands. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Runoff to untreated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. In cleaning of equipment, do not allow oil or wastes to contaminate water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

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Follow application of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label.

INSTRUCTIONS: Read entire Directions for Use before using this type insecticide.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Household: Store containers in water tank or feed by outside and dry area. Do not mix with water. Prevent cross-contamination with other pesticides. Store in closed and tight. Store in original container out of reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.

Household: Do not reuse empty containers. Wash and put in trash collection.

Pesticide Disposal (Except household): Varies depending upon the use of this product may be disposed on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal (Except household): Do not use containers in connection with food, feed or drinking water. Completely empty bag or application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag or equipment, tightly closed. If empty, do not exceed the limits allowed by State and Local authorities. Do not burn, do not cut or damage.

Household Use: Do not contaminate in a manner so to prevent application of the material. If leaking or material spilled for any reason, do not, carefully sweep material into a pile. RESTRICTIONS

Do not spray grass and for food storage. Use only according to label directions.

RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS ON LAWNS

WHITE GRUBS: Apply Tee Time Insecticide with Cydex uniformly at the rate of 3-4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. with an accurately calibrated lawn spreader. For best results, mow lawn and rake dead grass from damaged spots before applying. After applying uniformly, water lawn using 15-30 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. Do not water again for at least three days. Resupply as necessary at one to three week intervals. In most areas, the first application should be May or June. Consult your state Agricultural Experiment Station or State Extension Service specialist for more specific information regarding timing of applications.

SOIL WEBWORMS (LAWN MOTHS): Apply Tee Time Insecticide with Cydex at the rate of 2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Using the above application techniques and recommendations.

SUGGESTED SPREADER SETTINGS

1 LB.	W	B
2 LB.	81-04	C
3 LB.	81-04	D
4 LB.	81-04	E

Note: These spreader settings are approximate. Differences may occur due to variation of spreader, extent of which applied and roughness of areas to be treated. Because areas to be treated will not cover an under apply, close spreader when filling, turning or stopping. DO NOT HAND SPREAD.
