<u>White Grubs</u> (such as Japanese Beetle, Chafer Beetles, <u>Phyllophaga</u> spp., and Green June beetle grubs), Bluegrass billbugs, European crane fly larvae	3.0	For white grub control, applications should be made when grubs are feeding near the soil surface, usually during late March through May or July to early September, or as recommended by local agricultural extension agents. For most effective control the material should be watered in by the applicator, or, the applicator shall instruct the owner of the property to water-in the material sufficiently to wash the insecticide into the zone of insect infestation. Repeat applications may be made as needed for control of new infestations.
