

RECOMMENDED APPLICATIONS ON LAWNS AND ORNAMENTAL TURFS

WHITE GRUBS: Apply Tee Time Insecticide with Dvlox uniformly at the rate of lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. with an accurately calibrated lawn spreader. For best results, mow lawn and rake dead grass from damaged spots before applying. After applying uniformly, water lawn using 15-30 gallons per 1000 sq. ft. Do not water again for at least three days. Reapply as necessary at one to three week intervals. In most areas, the first application should be May or June. Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station or State Extension Service Specialists for more specific information regarding timing of applications.

SOD WEBWORMS (LAWN MOTHS): Apply Tee Time Insecticide with Dvlox at the rate of 2 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. using the above application techniques and recommendations.
