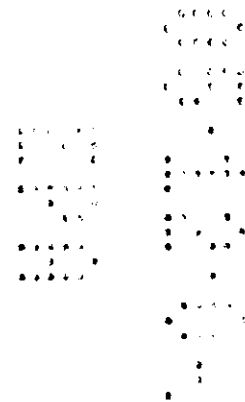

Dollar Spot:

Preventative Rate 1.5 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -
Apply recommended rate on 30 day intervals. Protective activity of Bayleton fungicide may extend for as long as 60 days dependent on environmental conditions.

Preventative Rate 0.75 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -

Cure Rate 3.0 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -

Anthraxnose, Poa annua Decline:

Preventative Rate 3.0 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -
Apply at 30 day intervals and repeat as necessary for seasonal control. Dependent upon environmental conditions, residual control may be extended to 45 days.

Preventative Rate 1.5 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -
Apply at 21 day intervals and repeat as necessary for seasonal conditions, residual control may be extended to 30 days.

Cure Rate 3.0 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -

Stripe Smut:

Preventative Rate Only 3.0 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -
Make a single application in spring as grass growth begins.

Fusarium Blight (*Fusarium culmorum*) (Fusarium poae), Summer Patch (*Phialophora gramineola*) (California only):

Preventative Rate Only 3.0 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -
Apply first application in mid-June or 30 days prior to time this blight normally becomes evident. Applications should be made at the 6 lb. rate on 15 day intervals.

Fusarium Blight (*Fusarium culmorum*) (Fusarium poae), Summer Patch (*Phialophora gramineola*) (California only):

Preventative Rate Only 3.0 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -
Apply first application in mid-June or 30 days prior to time this blight normally becomes evident. Applications should be made at the 6 lb. rate on 15 day intervals.

Gray Snow Mold (*Typhula incarnata*) (Except California):

Preventative Rate Only 8.0 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -
Apply in fall 30 days prior to turf dormancy. If turf breaks dormancy during winter months, a second application should be made. Do not apply over snow cover or when turf is dormant.

Pink Snow Mold, Fusarium Patch (*Microdochium nivale*), Southern Blight (*Sclerotium rolfsii*):

Preventative Rate Only 3.0 to 6.0 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -
Apply before conditions favorable for infection occur. Reapplication should be made as needed at 60 to 90 day interval. Do not apply over snow cover or when turf is dormant. Use higher rate in areas with a history of severe disease damage.

Gray Snow Mold (*Typhula incarnata*), Pink Snow Mold (*Microdochium nivale*) (California Only):
Preventative Rate Only, Single Application 7.5 to 12 Lbs./1,000 Sq. Ft. -
Apply in late fall before first snow cover. Do not apply over snow cover. Use the high rate in areas

with a history of severe snow mold damage.

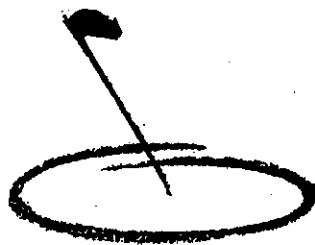
