The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Under "Environmental Hazards", change the third sentence to "Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark." Add, "do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."

LAWN AND ORNAMENTAL TURF

For a preventive disease control program (4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) set spreader at the regular rate indicated on this bag. For eradicated spot treatment of severely diseased areas, set spreader for 1 1/2 rate. (6 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.)

For best results, the lawn should be moist when making application. Just after a light shower or in the morning when dew is on the grass is ideal. TURF FUNGICIDE should not be applied when rain is expected within 24 hours. DO NOT WATER OR MOW FOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS AFTER APPLICATION.

FOR CONTROL OF HELMINTHOSPORIUM LEAF SPOT, MELTING OUT and CURVULARIA, START application at PREVENTATIVE RATE in early spring and continue at 7-10 day intervals as long as wet weather prevails.

FOR CONTROL OF BROWN PATCH, DOLLAR SPOT, COPPER SPOT, GRAY LEAF SPOT and STEM RUST of BLUE GRASS, use at PREVENTATIVE RATE in early spring to early summer and continue at 7-14 day intervals into early fall.

SUGGESTED SPREADER SETTINGS

(Available at final printing)

Important: These settings are only approximate. Age and condition of spreader can cause wide variation. Be sure to calibrate your spreader with each application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**FOR HOMEOWNER USE ONLY:**
