### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

This product is for use on ornamental turfs to prevent and control Pythium and Sclerotium Blight and Snow Mold (Typhula). It also controls Brown Patch (Rhizoctonia Blight)

When used on greens and fairways, apply to moist foliage in the morning or evening. Sprinkle lightly just before traffic resumes to avoid pickup of material on shoes, golf balls or maintenance equipment.

### FOR USE ON ORNAMENTAL TURF

#### For Control of Brown Patch (Rhizoctonia Blight)

Apply this product at the rate of 5 lbs. per 2,300 square feet or 25 lbs. per 11,500 square. For control of brown patch on cool season lawns and turfs (such as creeping bentgrass, annual bluegrass, fescue and similar grasses) apply to moist foliage at the first signs of infection. Reapply every 7-10 days during warm, damp weather.

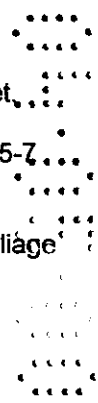
#### For Control of Pythium and Sclerotium Blight:

Apply this product at the rate of 5 lbs. per 2,300 square feet or 25 lbs. per 11,500 square feet.

Established Turf: Apply to moist foliage as soon as disease activity is observed. Repeat at 5-7 day intervals if high temperature and humidity conditions persists.

New Seedlings: Apply immediately after seeding. At first signs of disease, apply to moist foliage of newly germinated grass and repeat at 7-10 day intervals if evidence of disease persists.

When trying to control Pythium blight, do not fertilize or water heavily until disease activity is arrested. Prolonged contact with foliage enhances effectiveness.

**To Prevent Pythium and Sclerotium Blight:**

Apply this product at the rate of 5 lbs. per 2,300 square feet or 25 lbs. per 11,500 square feet to moist foliage when high temperatures and humidity favor development. Repeat at 5-7 day intervals as long as these weather conditions persist.

**Snow Mold (Typhula):**

Apply this product at the rate of 4.16 lbs. per 1,000 square feet or 25 lbs. per 6,000 square feet in the late fall, before the first snowfall and repeat again in January or any other mid-winter thaw. A final treatment in late winter as the snow melts extends protection. Do not apply to snow cover.

**Suggested Spreader Settings:**

*Note: listing of spreader and settings will be available at final printing and will vary due to market conditions.*

Note: These spreader settings were established using standard equipment available from the spreader manufacturer at swath widths and speeds typically used within the industry. It is recommended that all spreader equipment be calibrated at the time of application to achieve the desired application rate.

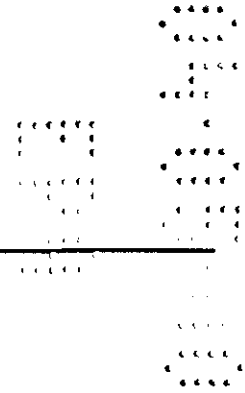
