On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Decision, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Generic data requirements that have been identified in the RED as confirmatory data for the active ingredient contained in the subject product will continue to be tracked and assessed in the Agency's continual reassessment of pesticides.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the following comments.

- 1) Delete Fleas and Chiggers from your label since they must be supported by efficacy data.
- 2) Ants listing must exclude fire ants, carpenter ants pharoah ants and harvester ants.
- 3) Add to the Environmental hazard section "This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product if bees are visiting the treatment areas."

You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this Notice or the next printing of the label whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. Directions for Use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

For use on turfgrass or dichondra on golf courses.

Restrictions:

Do not enter or allow others to enter until dusts have settled. Do not allow the public, especially children, on treated areas during treatment and until the pesticide is washed into the soil and turf is completely dry. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

Maximum application rate is 1 lb. chlorpyrifos per acre.

Armyworms Cricket

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Apply over entire area. Overlap spreader wheel tracks so no strips are missed.

Water as recommended after each application to wash product particles into the zone of insect activity. Do not mow or collect clippings for 24 hours after treatment.

CHINCH BUG control - apply any time activity or damage is noticed. Water thoroughly ($\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ inch) after each application.

CHINCH BUG prevention – apply as soon as daily temperatures reach 80° F or above and repeat at 2 month intervals. Water thoroughly (1/4 to 1/2 inch) after each application.

SOD WEBWORM, CUTWORM, EARWIG, FLEA BEETLE and VEGETABLE WEEVIL control – apply whenever insect activity is suspected. Sprinkle lightly after application to remove product particles from the leaves.

ANT, CRICKET and GRASSHOPPER control – apply whenever insect activity is observed or suspected. Water lightly after each application to remove particles from leaves.

HYPERODES WEEVIL control – apply as soon as grass greens in the spring and repeat in one month. Water lightly after application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a clean, dry place. Reseal opened bag by folding top down and securing.
