

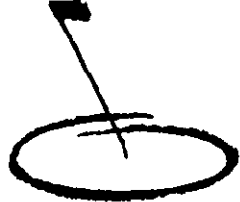

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

Apply any time weeds are actively growing. Do not apply when ground is frozen.

For bentgrass putting greens

For bentgrass putting greens apply at QUARTER RATE to moist foliage for control of clover and chickweed. Repeat treatment in 3 weeks if needed. (Treats 44,000 sq. ft.).

For use on other turfgrass areas

For turfgrass areas other than greens, apply to moist or dry foliage at—

HALF RATE to control clover (treats 22,000 sq. ft.).

NORMAL RATE to control knotweed, chickweed (common and mouse-ear), sheep sorrel and black medick (treats 11,000 sq. ft.).

DOUBLE RATE to control wild onion and garlic, curly dock, ground ivy, Canada thistle, oxtail, yellow and horsenead. For control of yellow and wild onion and garlic start treatments in either spring or fall and repeat at 6 month intervals for a total of 2 or 3 applications as needed (treats 5,500 sq. ft.).

Delay planting grass seed until after a heavy rain or watering and not sooner than two weeks after treatment.
