Apply any time weeds are actively growing. Do not apply when ground is frozen.

For bentgrass putting greens

For bentgrass putting greens apply at 0.81 lbs./1,000 sq.ft. to moist foliage for control of clover and chickweed. Repeat treatment in 3 weeks if needed.

For use on other turfgrass areas

For turfgrass areas other than greens, apply to moist or dry foliage at -

Delay planting grass seed until after a heavy rain or watering and not sooner than two weeks after treatment.

For use on fine fescue or bentgrass turf maintained at a height of ½ inch or above, use at the LOW RATE or LIGHT RATE setting.
