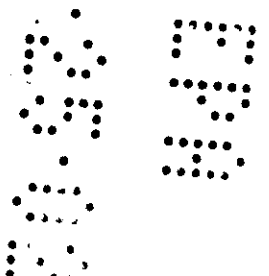

Make all applications to dry foliage only. If maximum daytime temperature is 80°F or above, water sufficiently to rinse particles off the grass blades.

Application can be made to newly sprigged St. Augustine and zoysia turf. Prior to this treatment, however, water should be applied to settle the soil around the sprigs.

USE LIMITATIONS

Do not apply to lawns of bahia, bluegrass, bentgrass, dichondra, ryegrass, tall fescue, bermudagrass or mixed lawns containing any of these grasses.

Do not use on centipede or carpetgrass turf during the period of winter dormancy (approximately October 15 to March 15), except in Florida.

Do not apply to newly seeded zoysia, centipede or carpetgrass until after the turf has been mowed at least twice.

Do not plant sprigs for one month or sow new grass seed for six months following application of this product.
