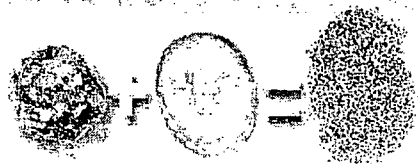

TO PREVENT DOLLAR SPOT, ANTHRACNOSE AND RUST (*Puccinia spp.*), apply to moist or dry foliage at the RECOMMENDED RATE when environmental conditions favor disease activity. Repeat the application at 2 week intervals throughout the expected disease period.

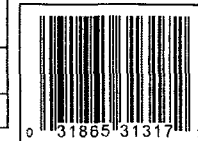
