This product can be applied at 4 to 8 week intervals at the FULL RATE and 2 to 4 week intervals at the HALF RATE. The HALF RATE should be used on overseeded greens only after successful establishment. Applications should not be made after April 1st since late applications may temporarily delay resumption of bermudagrass growth and green-up in the spring.

On turl containing significant populations of Poa annua, HALF RATES should be used to avoid temporary discoloration.

HOW TO USE

Apply to dry foliage. For best results, water in (at least 1/4 inch) within 48 hours after application. Continue normal cultural practices after application

RESULTS TO EXPECT

Greening of bentorass and perennial ryegrass/Kentuc..v bluegrass turf areas and overseeded greens and tees will be deoper and, " depending on rate and frequency, will last up to 10 weeks.

On overseeded greens, a more uniform and dense outling surface will result

With repeat applications, growth of turf will be reduced resulting in improved density and playability of turl.

Increased tillering of ryegrass and reduction in stolon length of bentgrass have been observed. Lower water use rates of turf have been documented as well as a reduction in volume of clippings with repeated use.

Program Scheduling

Apply at least 14 days after overseeding with perennial ryegrass.

If weeds, disease or insect problems occur, apply a recommended control product in the same manner as is normally practiced, since the use of this product is compatible with existing control products and cultural practices.

Not for use on athletic fields under heavy traffic where maximum prowth optential of turf is desired. Not for use on sod farms.
