TO PREVENT DOLLAR SPOT, ANTHRACNOSE, POWDERY MILDEW AND RUST (*Puccinia* spp.) apply to moist or dry foliage at the LOW RATE when environmental conditions favor disease activity. Repeat at two week intervals throughout the expected disease period.

TO CONTROL ACTIVE DOLLAR SPOT, ANTRACNOSE, POWDERY MILDEW AND RUST (*Puccinia* spp.) apply to moist or dry foliage at two week intervals. Use the MEDIUM RATE for light to moderate disease infestations and the HIGH RATE for severe disease infestations. When the disease activity is under control, apply at the LOW RATE at two week intervals.

TO PREVENT BROWN PATCH apply to moist or dry foliage at the MEDIUM RATE when environmental conditions favor disease activity. Repeat the application at two week intervals throughout the expected disease period.

TO CONTROL ACTIVE BROWN PATCH apply to moist or dry foliage at the HIGH RATE every two weeks. When the disease activity is under control, apply at the MEDIUM RATE at two week intervals.
