



How to Apply:

Apply uniformly over the treatment area with either a broadcast or drop lyne-speeder, avoiding spreadurs which will apply product in narrow, concentrated bands. "Apply only the specified amount in the following table. Calturals the spreader before use and check periodically to ensure the equipment is working properly.
