To reduce annoyance from mosquitoes, use one or more candles in still air. Never leave a burning candle unattended. Do not use water to extinguish. Straighten wick before lighting. For outdoor use only. Place securely in ground away from house, shrubbery or any other potential fire hazard. When placing in ground, hold at the bottom of wooden stake and push in. Do not push from top. Proper supervision should be exercised when burning candle. To extinguish: Leave candle in the ground and wither pour sand (or dirt) gently over flame, or cover the flame with an empty soup can. Let candle stand for 1/2 hour before touching. To light, lift wax coated paper wick at top and apply flame directly to paper. (Do NOT remove the label).
