- c. Revise the label declaration for the active ingredient CITRONELLA OIL to read as OIL OF CITRONELLA.
- d. Expand the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS statement to appear as follows:

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public water unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in a NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or a Regional Office of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.


