1. To clean, disinfect and deodorize walls, floors, and other nonporous surfaces, use 1 ounce of Cleaner-Disinfectant per gallon of water.
2. To clean, disinfect and deodorize porous and heavily contaminated surfaces, use 1 ounce of Cleaner-Disinfectant per gallon of water with special attention given to thorough cleaning.
3. To fog an unoccupied room as an adjunct either preceding or following regular cleaning and disinfecting procedure, use a dilution of 1:42 or 3 ounces Cleaner-Disinfectant per gallon of water per average size room. Allow minimum of 15 minutes after fogging has stopped before entering room.

GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

1. To clean, disinfect and deodorize walls, floors, tables, fountains, sinks, refrigerators, stoves, restroom fixtures, train booths, animal and bird cages, kennels, and garbage cans, use a solution containing 1 ounce of Cleaner-Disinfectant per gallon of water.
2. To clean and disinfect such articles as combs, hair brushes, scissors, instruments and rubber goods: Wipe articles, one by one, for ten minutes in a solution containing 2 ounces of Cleaner-Disinfectant per gallon of water.
3. To disinfect fabrics such as sheets, linens, aprons, etc., soak for ten minutes in solution containing 1 ounce of Cleaner-Disinfectant per gallon of water.
4. To clean grease laden or grossly contaminated surfaces, use 2 ounces of Cleaner-Disinfectant per gallon of water.
