The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with
registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide
Act, is acceptable provided that you make the following revisions before
you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Under Hospital Use Directions include "nonporous, inanimate"
after "hard" in item 1. (Refer to comment 4, paragraph 1,
in our letter of September 26, 1988.)
2. In the first paragraph under Description (top of left side panel),
delete "in one operation" from the second sentence. No data
have been submitted to support a one-step claim.

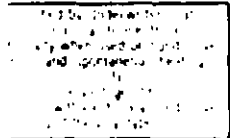

 thoroughly wet. Allow surfaces to remain wet for 10 minutes. All surfaces must be rinsed with clean water and
 to dry before use. For cutting brushes, razors, scissors, instruments, and rubber goods: Apply
 Advantage 256 to remove heavy soil and gross dirt. Wipe articles clean and soak for 10 minutes in a minimum
 of 1 ounce of Product Disinfectant per gallon of water at 1:256. Rinse all articles with clean water.
 For other fabrics, such as sheets, linens, aprons, and uniforms: First pre-clean to remove gross dirt. Then
